The initiative must have been released onto the market less than three years ago, and can demonstrate improvement to the sustainability of a pool or spa. For example, it could be a new pool water minimisation device, advances in solar heating products, automation, advances in pool cover technology, any low energy activity or device, or the promotion of a more sustainable use of existing systems or processes.

All entrants <u>must</u> introduce their entry with a 200 word (max) written overview of what the product is and how it works. Entrants are then to provide a written response that addresses the key areas considered by our judges:	
> Application within the market	> Compliance with regulations

Closing date for entries & full payment is 5pm Friday, 14th April 2017. This official SPASA Entry Form must be used for category 41 Award entries. Please complete one Entry Form per entry.

Members are asked to provide both a digital and printed submission that details Product Description, Product Advantages and demonstrated use.

Entrants should submit a presentation that utilises photography, testimonials, moving images (if available), copy advertising, etc. You're encouraged to be creative and to provide a wide array of supporting materials.

Wherever possible, entrants should deliver a sample of the product to SPASA with their submission. The judges may also request a phone interview with the member as a part of the adjudication process.

Microsoft PowerPoint, PDF and Word are the preferred digital formats for entries. There is no maximum or minimum size for entries. All entry material provided will remain strictly confidential. Please refer to the "Terms & Conditions of Entry" for full details.
