- Inventor Gary Powell forms partnership with Randy Sellers to market technology 2015
- Polar Vortex a device to increase snow production is released 2016
- Pool Tiger a device to purify water in swimming pools is released 2017
- Currently in development:
 - System to purify consumable water in homes, multi-unit housing & hotels
 - Device to remove scaling and organic debris in cooling towers



Hydraulic Harmonics - How Pool Tiger Works




A portion of the water that enters the chamber is channeled into specially designed nozzles that convert water to water vapor.

Upon exiting the nozzles the vapor bubbles collapse and revert back to water. This instantaneous dual conversion creates a heat signature and a harmonic signature.



Heat Signature – Dissipation Strata




Pool Tiger is designed with a specific ratio of nozzles to chamber volume to effectively kill contaminants, control acids and eliminate toxic organic compounds without affecting pool temperatures.



Cavitation & Negative Ions

The rapid formation and collapse of water vapor bubbles not only creates heat but also negatively charges water molecules. These molecules, called "negative ions," are highly kinetic.



Cavitation infuses water with negative ions. This process also imparts a negative charge to suspended particles.



Agglomeration (aka Flocculation)



Suspended particles

- a. make pool water look cloudy
- b. build up on pool walls

Not a Pool Tiger Pool!



Agglomeration

Most particles are too small to be captured by the filter. Imparting a negative charge to particles causes them to attract one another so they agglomerate. Once the agglomeration reaches sufficient size, it is easily captured.



Eliminating suspended particles = Clear, sparkling water

How Negative Ions Clean and Protect Pool Surfaces

Cleaning

Negatively charged water molecules are highly active and serve to gently scrub away buildup on pool walls. They are also able to permeate buildup and displace the particles, salts, minerals and even algae roots that have accumulated. These properties significantly reduce the need to brush.



Protection

In outdoor pools negative ions accumulate at pool walls and form a highly ordered water state known as the Exclusionary Zone. The EZ repels suspended particles, salts, minerals and even algae.
