

Pool owners should be aware of water conservation strategies to ensure they are responsible users of water.

It's easy to transform your backyard pool into a Water Neutral pool!

WHAT IS A WATER NEUTRAL POOL?

In order to be certified as 'Water Neutral', a pool must have the following key water saving features:

- 1 Water tank, to collect rainfall to top-up the pool as needed
- 2 Pool cover, to conserve 90% of water lost through evaporation
- 3 Backwash minimisation system, to prevent excessive backwashing (e.g. cartridge filter, oversized sand filter, centrifugal / pre-filter device, backwash recycle system etc)
- 4 Energy Efficient Equipment

THE BENEFITS OF A CERTIFIED WATER NEUTRAL POOL

You will pay less for water, maintenance and pool chemicals. At the same time you will reduce your pool's environmental impact, while enjoying the benefits of a pool.

A Water Neutral Pool can save more than 6,000 litres of water every year, which can be used in toilets, laundries and the garden.
