History

The CASPA Cup was a competitive event run during each National Convention. It consisted of various events such as swimming, running, rowing, golf etc, and the award was presented and held by the winning State Association.

The last time it was run was in Hawaii, and was won by Victoria (as the organizer and host) for their brilliant team efforts at rowing an outrigger long boat in Waikiki.

The Cup is currently held in its rightful place - the Victorian SPASA State office.

Traditionally, the host state organized the event, and, as a result, it was inevitably won by that State.
